Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant: -\$1,100

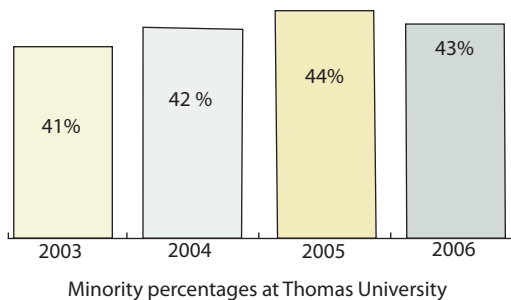
Georgia Hope Scholarship: -\$3,000

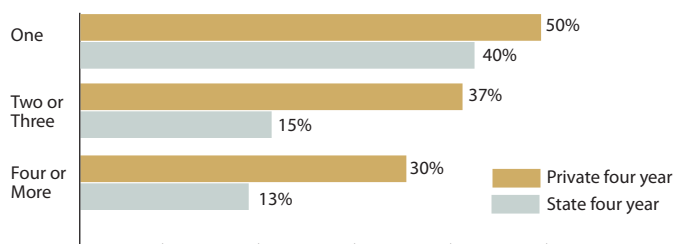

The percentage of students from racial and ethnic minorities at Thomas University is comparable to that of four-year state institutions.



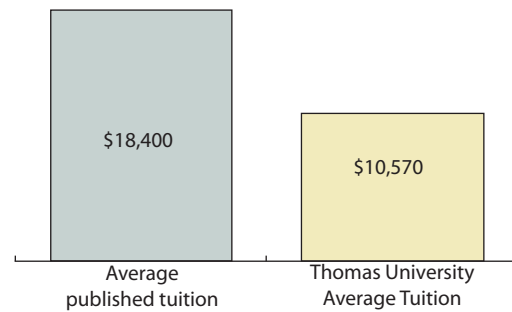
# fact 5

Students who work full-time, have a high school equivalency diploma, or face other challenges are far more likely to graduate from a private college or university than a state institution.



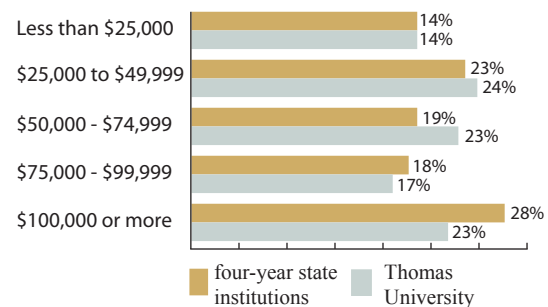
# fact 2
