Packing for college is an exciting time! You don't want to forget anything, so you pack up everything you own and buy anything you think may need. However, you must take into consideration that your roommate(s) will do the exact same thing. Here is a packing list of recommended things to bring, what you should share with your roommate(s) and what to leave at home. Don't feel like you need to purchase all of these items before you arrive on campus, there are stores in Thomasville that sell the items listed.

Each unit is furnished with the following items:

- Stove/oven, microwave oven, full size refrigerator/freezer, washer/dryer
- Sofa, love seat, coffee table, end table, tv table, wall mounted 50' flat screen tv, kitchen table w/ 4 chairs, ceiling fan
- Each unit has its own WiFi access point and cable tv service is provided

Each bedroom is furnished with the following items:

• Full size bed, desk, chair, 4 drawer dresser, pedestal/nightstand, wall mounted 32" flat screen tv, closet

What to Bring:

- Computer and printer
- Power strips for computers/electronics
- Desk lamp
- Alarm clock
- Storage and organizing units
- Curtains for your room the curtain rods are already mounted the windows measure 36" wide x 58" high Do not get full length curtains, they won't fit due to the furniture It is important to note that <u>only Room B and Room C in the unit have a window</u> (Keep your receipt so you can return any items you don't need)
- Waste basket one that doesn't leak
- Movies/DVDs
- VCR/DVD player (bedroom)
- Sheets, blankets, mattress pad and pillows (Full size beds)
- Laundry basket and soap
- Clothes hangers
- Toiletries & Towels
- First aid kit
- Batteries
- Pictures from home
- Posters/personal decorations
- 3M Sticky strips for posters (no tack, screws, or nails allowed in walls)
- Calendar/planner
- Cleaning Supplies (to use for bathroom and everyday cleaning)
- School supplies

What to Share:

- Shower mat/rug (we recommend 2 rectangle mats, and 1 for the base of the toilet)
- Shower curtain & liner & curtain rings (<u>Curtain and liner must be 78 inches</u> 72 inch curtains and liners will not work!!)
- VCR/DVD player (living room)
- Waste basket for the bathrooms and kitchens
- Stereo
- Dry-erase board (to put up on your door)
- Kitchen supplies pots, pans, cooking utensils, dish soap, sponges, mats for the floor, trash bags, and trash can
- Dishes, silverware, cups, etc. We recommend the dollar store for these items plastic plates and cups are inexpensive, and can be disposed of at the end of the year so you don't have to pack them for the trip home – this can be a shared expense to save everyone!
- Curtains for the common area the curtain rods are already mounted the windows measure 60 inches wide by 58 inches tall – do not get floor length curtains – they won't fit due to furniture

What <u>NOT</u> to Bring:

- Halogen lamps
- Candles
- Sun lamps
- Weapons
- Decorative lights (Christmas lights, neon lights, etc.)
- Air conditioners
- Pets
- Illegal drugs
- Alcohol
- Fireworks
