Work continues on new pavilion, courtyard



Progress continues on the new pavilion and courtyard located on the Magnolia Campus next to the two residence halls. Once completed, the courtyard will include a new upgraded beach volleyball court, picnic tables with sunshades, trees, sidewalks and a pavilion. The 25-foot by 40-foot pavilion will feature a tongue-and-groove ceiling, a metal roof, stone columns, ceiling fans, seating and gas grills. The area will be a place for students to gather and enjoy time together. It will also be an ideal location for Student Activities' events such as cookouts and game nights. The pavilion and courtyard will be completed in early September.
