

Outcome

Graduates will be able to demonstrate critical skills in research, analysis, synthesis, creative problem solving and evaluation through written and oral presentation.

Assessment

Students must produce satisfactory Senior Thesis on a topic in Humanities or fine arts project and make a formal presentation of it.

Goal

The thesis and presentation will be evaluated by a scoring rubric. 90% of students completing the course each semester will achieve competency (4.5 or higher); 70% of students completing the course each semester will achieve mastery (3.5 or higher).

Graduates will be able to demonstrate acquisition, utilization, and evaluation of knowledge, skills, and perspectives related to at least one career field

Students must produce satisfactory Senior Thesis and make a formal presentation of it.

The thesis and presentation will be evaluated by a scoring rubric. 90% of students successfully completing the course each semester will achieve competency (4.5 or higher); 70% of students successfully completing the course each semester will achieve mastery (3.5 or higher).

Graduates will be able to demonstrate an understanding of the essential principles and critical approaches of art, music, rhetoric and history.

Students must take four prescribed upper-division courses in the Interdisciplinary Core (Art 304, 305 or 306; English 302, 303 or 304; History 304 or 451 and Music 337, 340 or 344). All IDS Core courses require a paper and some kind of presentation that develops capability for producing the Senior Thesis.

100% of students will achieve a B or higher in IDS Core courses outside their chosen discipline concentration.

Graduates will be able to integrate experiential learning from an applied art into their understanding of artistic expression.

Students must complete one or more applied art (visual art, music or drama) as part of their degree program.

100% of students will achieve a B or higher in one or more applied art course.
