



Program Completion Rates

RN – BSN:

Outcome Goal: $\geq 70\%$ of students will complete the RN- BSN program ***On time*** beginning with enrollment in first NSG course and ending with graduation or exiting of program.

(Enrollment data counting semesters from first day of 1st BSN NSG course taken and ends with completion of course required for degree conferral or exiting of program.)

Rationale: students have work and family responsibilities

MSN:

Outcome Goal: $\geq 60\%$ of students will complete their graduate nursing program ***On time*** beginning with enrollment in first NSG course based on program option designated semesters ending with graduation or exiting of program.

(Enrollment data counting semesters from first day of 1st MSN NSG course taken and ends with completion of course required for degree conferral or exiting of program.)

Rationale: Students have work and family responsibilities; many do not have financial support from employers and some drop out to change to nurse practitioner degree after taking basic courses that will transfer. Additionally, some students who begin the RN- MSN program decide to switch to the BSN in order to graduate sooner.
