

The Stop Campus Hazing Act of 2024 (SCHA) is a federal law designed to prevent hazing and increase transparency on college campuses. Hazing includes any act that causes harm, intimidation, or forces risky behavior during group membership or initiation—whether or not someone consents.

Twice a year as part of its compliance with the SCHA, Thomas University is required to report incidences of hazing and make its report available to the public on its website. The report, which may be accessed [here](#), will include the date of the incident, location of the incident, the organization indicated in the complaint, the outcome of the investigation, the sanction levied, and whether there was an appeal.
